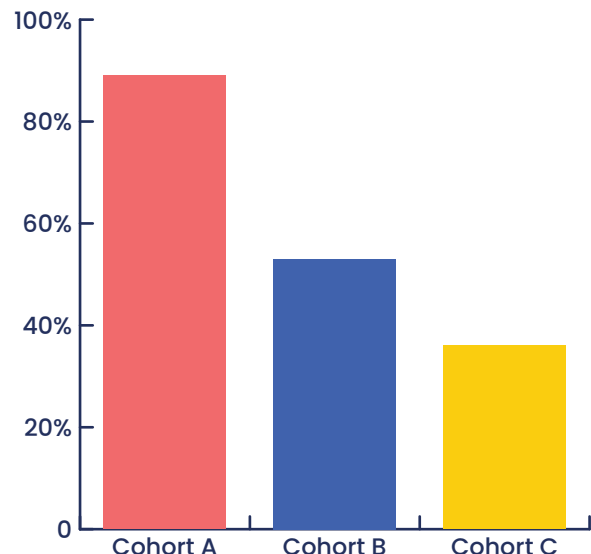
Third Grade End-of-Year Performance
