

## Lesson: Introduction to Months of the Year

Grade Level(s): Kindergarten Concept(s): Months, Reading Duration: 25-30 minutes

Objective: Students will practice reciting and recognizing the months of the year while engaging

in a fun and active jumping activity.

#### **Materials Needed:**

- Months of the Year Hop
- Tape

### **Lesson Procedure** (5 minutes):

#### **Engage Students:**

- Greet the students and introduce the activity by showing them the floor mat.
- Ask: "Can you name all the months of the year?" Allow the students to share what they know.

#### **Explain the Activity:**

• Explain: "Today, we're going to jump down this mat and say each month as we go. Let's practice saying them together first!"

#### **Demonstrate the Activity:**

Recite the months of the year together as a group before starting the activity.

## Activity (10-15 minutes):

#### **Student Participation:**

- Have the student stand on the "START HERE" spot.
- As they jump from one month to the next, have them say the name of the month aloud.
- If they struggle with a word, say it for them and have them repeat it before moving forward.
- Ensure they pronounce each month correctly before jumping to the next.
- Continue until they reach the end of the mat.

#### Repetition & Mastery:

 Repeat the activity multiple times until the students are comfortable reciting all 12 months correctly.

### Closure (5 minutes):

#### **Discussion:**

- Ask: "Can you say the months without looking at the mat?"
- Ask: "Which months have names that sound alike?"

#### Reflection:

- Ask:
  - "What was your favorite part of this activity?"
  - "Which months were the hardest to remember?"

#### **Celebrate Success:**

• Give positive feedback and praise their effort.

### **Assessment:**

• Observation: Monitor students' pronunciation and confidence.

#### Differentiation:

#### **Support:**

 Allow them to step instead of hop and provide extra guidance. Use clapping or stomping instead of jumping.

#### Challenge:

- Have them spell the months, or say a fact about each month as they land on it.
- Have them jump to the month it is.

## **Extension Activity**

#### **Reverse Order Challenge:**

Have the student jump backward down the mat, saying the months in reverse order.

#### **Find Your Birthday Month:**

Ask the student to jump to their birthday month and say it loud and proud.

#### Months & Seasons:

As they jump, have them say which season each month belongs to.
